Baptist Children's Homes of North Carolina (BCH) provides residential services for developmentally disabled adults in locations around North Carolina. BCH's Developmental Disabilities Ministry (DDM) is designed to provide a safe living



environment with a Christian atmosphere that includes opportunities for spiritual enrichment, preparation of nutritious meals, transportation,

enhancement of daily and independent living skills and social skills. We promote and support maximum independence, individual growth, and inclusion in their community.

Residential Care Rates:

Rates will be the maximum amount allowed and approved by the North Carolina General Assembly and/or the Social Services Commission of the North Carolina Department of Human Resources. Applicants must be eligible for funding sources if not paying privately.



Application Process: Only persons whose needs can be adequately met in a group home setting will be considered for placement. Placement decisions are made in the best interest of the applicant and the desired facility with consideration given to proximity to family/guardian.

There are certain behavioral, medical and mental illness needs which the DDM program is not equipped to serve. Lifetime contracts or legal guardianship are not offered. DDM homes are single gender six bed facilities and are alcohol and smoke free environments.

Admission Criteria: Applicants must be legal residents of North Carolina to be considered for placement.

Applicants must:

- be at least 18 years of age
- have developmental disability diagnosis
- be ambulatory or able to self-transfer and continent
- have or can develop self-help skills
- be free of any contagious or communicable disease
- be free from alcohol and/or drug addiction
- provide the facility with any past psychological, medical evaluation and social history
- be able to communicate verbally or have a form of communication that can be understood by staff
- be capable of participating in a day program or job placement
